With the help of our incredible staff and valued retailers, everyone won in 2016. The New Hampshire Lottery raised a record-breaking \$308 million in sales, retailers earned over \$18 million in commissions and our players received almost \$200 million in prizes. Talk about a successful year.

As a proud sponsor of education, giving back to New Hampshire's public school system has always been a top priority for the Lottery. Contributing over \$79 million to this worthy cause is amongst our greatest achievements in fiscal year 2016.

We also experienced some huge milestones with Powerball. The Powerball jackpot reached an all-time high of \$1.5 billion, which increased sales by an outstanding 47% or \$13.6 million from the previous year in just two weeks.

Since its inception in 1964, the New Hampshire Lottery has had a significant impact on the state contributing nearly \$1.8 billion to education, giving over \$3.8 billion back to our players and recording almost \$6 billion in lottery sales and other earnings. We are so proud of this impressive list of accomplishments and look forward to the challenge ahead of us.

I would also like to offer my sincere thanks to the Executive Council for their continuous support of the Lottery and its mission to strengthen New Hampshire public schools: Joseph D. High-Speed Scratch Off contest at the New Hampshire Motor Speedway to family events at The Home Depot stores, there was never a dull moment. We were especially excited to bring the first live drawing to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats stadium to award over \$1.3 million to a few lucky winners.

The New Hampshire Lottery also introduced the new "Chief Luck Officer." Chuck McLuck. Between a series of commercials, various promotions, a dedicated website and an Instagram account, Chuck McLuck quickly became everyone's favorite eccentric adventurer.

Across the board, it was another successful year in sales. Our partners at the Racing and Charitable Gaming division brought in \$5 million through games like Bingo and Lucky 7. Powerball, Mega Millions, Megabucks Plus, Lucky For Life, Pick 3/Pick 4 and Hot Lotto sales combined totaled a whopping \$133 million. Fast Play sales continued to soar and rose by 32% from the previous year. All of this contributed to a record-breaking year for the New Hampshire Lottery with \$308 million in sales revenue.
